Then VOTE on Thursday, Sept 24 (a google survey link will be shared with you in your homeroom).

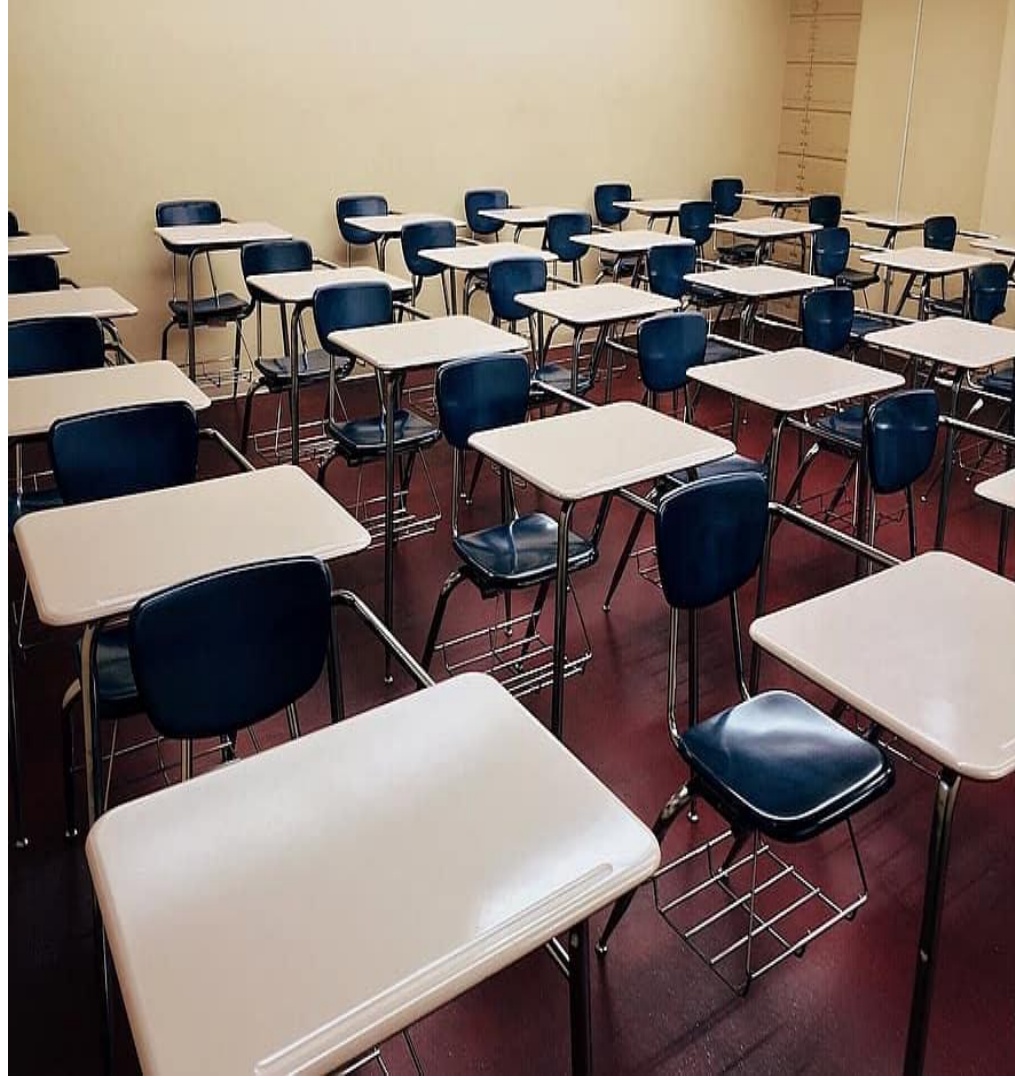
Every grade will need to elect the TWO people they feel will best represent them this school year.
