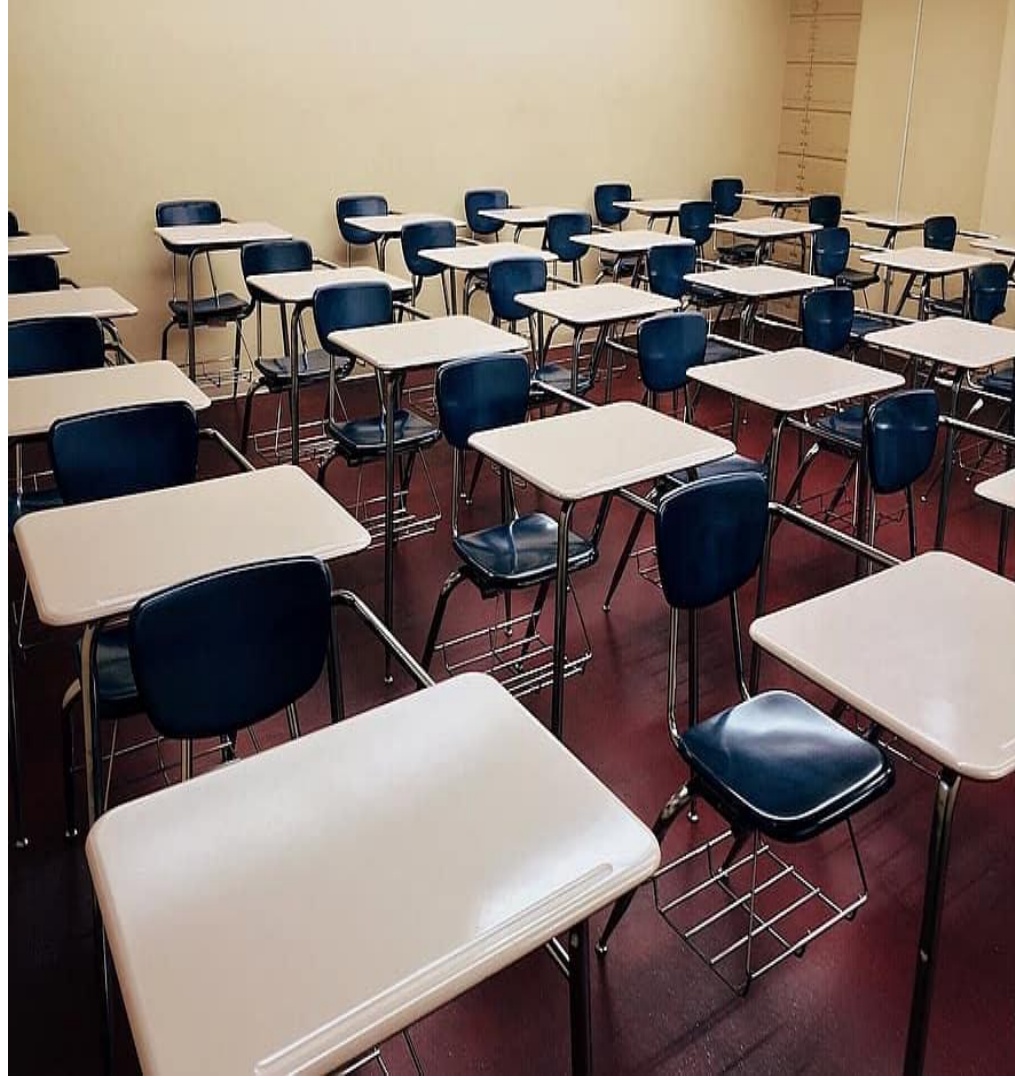
Process:
