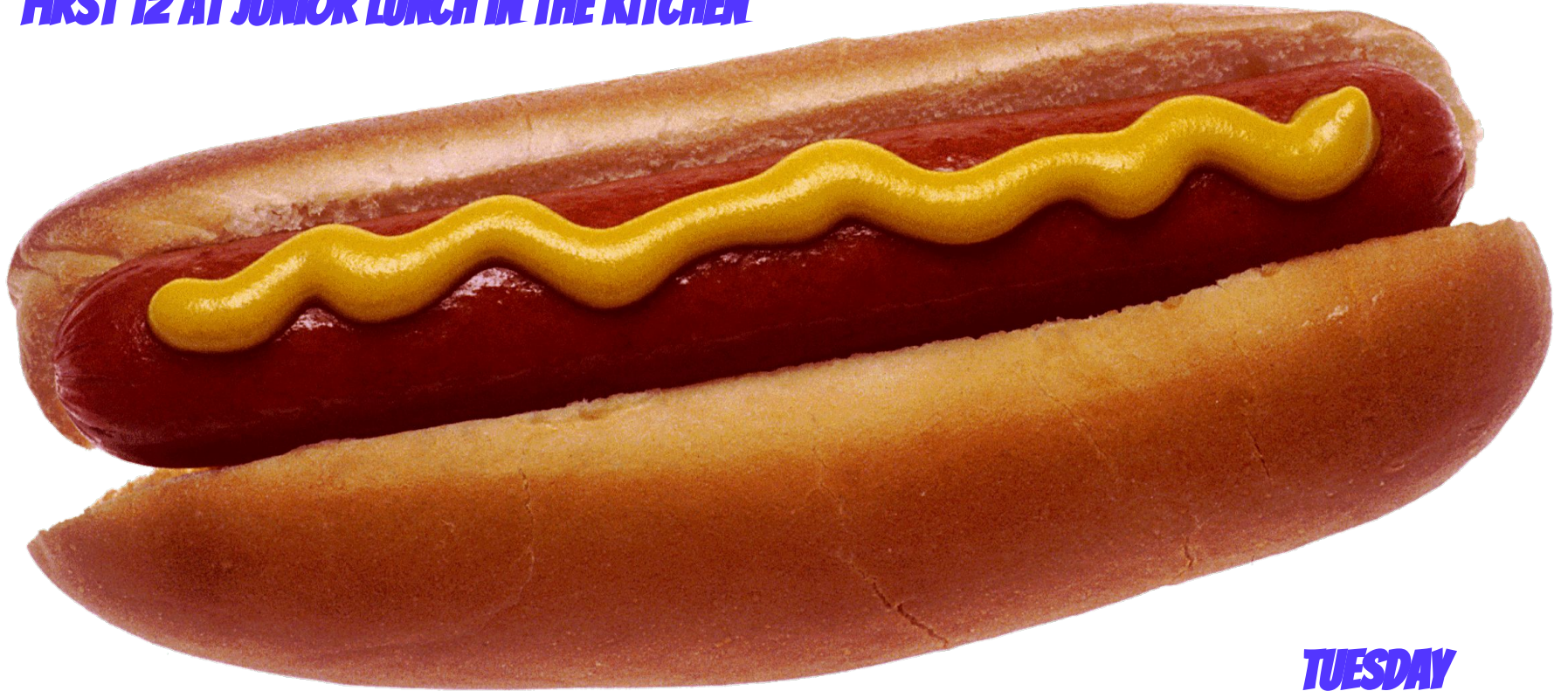

Run For It



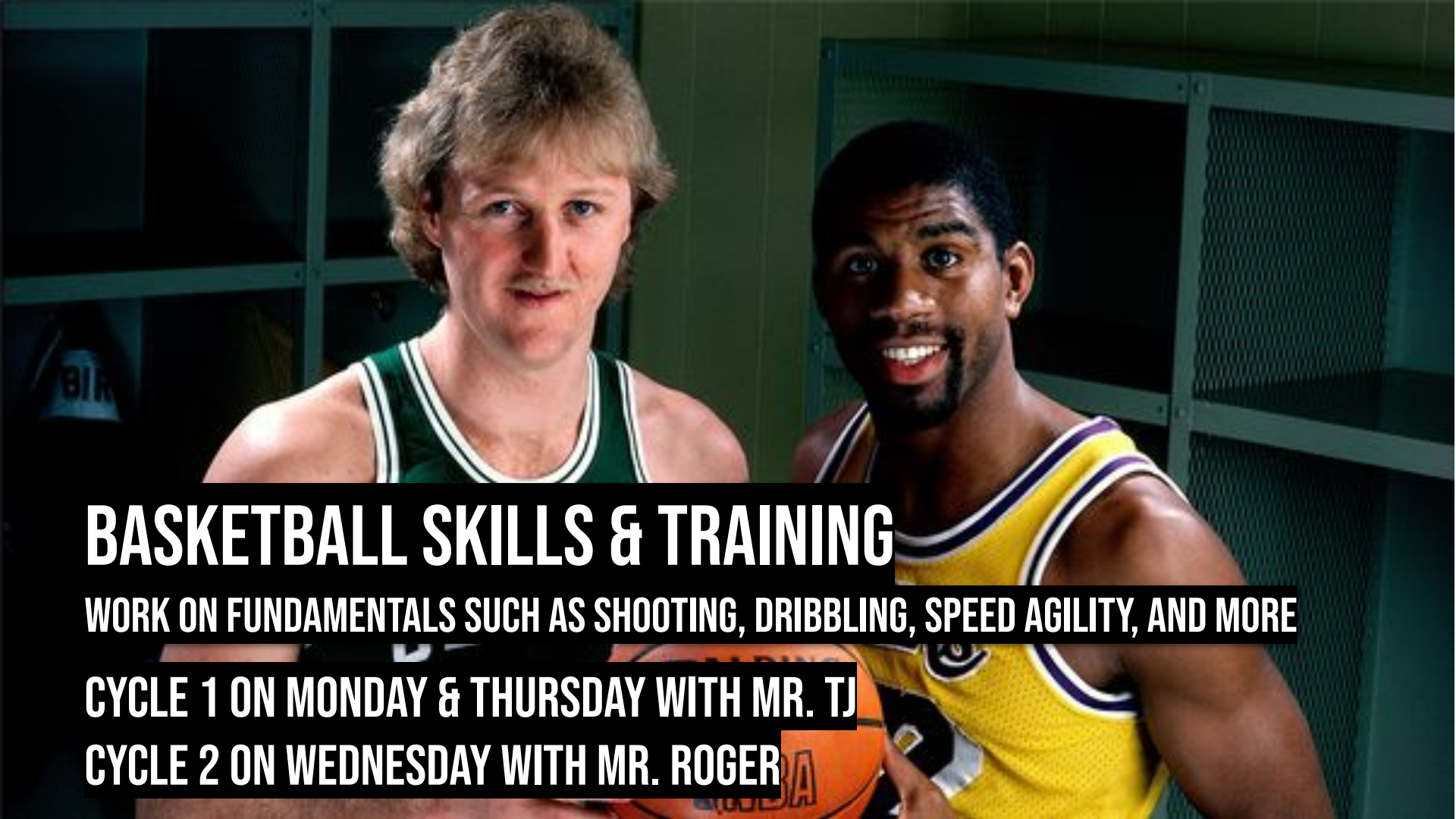

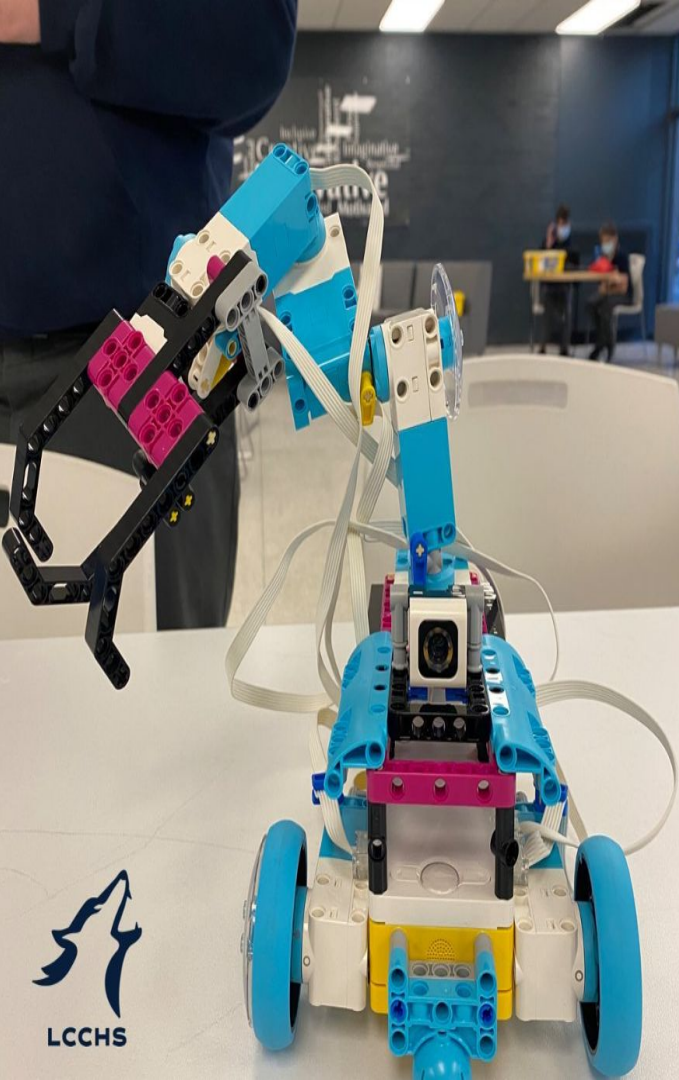
