LCCHS UNIFORM

All students are expected to be in full uniform at all times.



Uniform includes **grey pant/skorts, white or blue LCCHS tops, a crewneck sweater, and entirely black shoes. Please refer to your agenda.**

Non uniform shoes and athletic wear may be worn in Phys Ed. For hygiene purposes, it is your responsibility to be prepared and look presentable at school. It is a matter of pride!



THE LCCHS UNIFORM

Please be advised that if you arrive at school without your uniform, your parents will be called, and you will be sent home.

SHOES

Shoes must be entirely black.



During the winter months, you must change into your school shoes upon arrival and store your boots in your lockers.

SKIRT LENGTH

Only the skirt with integrated shorts are permitted. No rolling of skirts is permitted.

HEADWEAR

Headbands must be **PLAIN** (either blue or black). No hats or hoods may be worn indoors.

THE 6-DAY SCHEDULE

- The school day numbers can be found in the agenda
- Days are not counted on weekends and holidays
Example: If Friday is Day 3, the following Monday will be Day 4
- Students must be on time for ALL classes, including in the morning and after lunch

BE ON TIME!

- School begins with a warning bell at 8:50 am.
- You **MUST** be in your homeroom class by 8:55 am.
- You may arrive as of 8:15 a.m.
The cafeteria and library are open in the morning.

What If I am Late for school?

- If you are late for school in the morning, you will receive an **after-school detention**.
 - Your parent or guardian must call the school if you are late for a valid reason. Your lateness can be excused by a parent **3 times** throughout the school year.

What If I am Late after lunch?

- If you are late returning to class after lunch, you will receive an **after-school detention**.



What if I am late to class?

It is very disruptive to your teachers and classmates when you arrive late to class.

Parents are **automatically notified** when you are **late or absent**.

Being frequently late will result in being sent to the office.





LOCKERS

- You will share a locker for the year, and **you must not tell anyone your combination.**
- You **MUST** keep your locker **locked** between classes and at the end of the day. **The school is not responsible for items missing from unlocked lockers.**
- **NO SWITCHING OF LOCKERS** is permitted without permission.
- Please keep your locker and the locker area clean and do not loiter in the locker area

Cellphones, Headphones, and Earbuds

- Cell phone/headphone/earbud use are **NOT** permitted during class time
- Staff members **will confiscate** phones taken out during class time or between classes
- Urgent calls are **not an excuse**. Urgent calls to and from home are to be carried out **at the office**
- Confiscated cell phones and earbuds will be kept at the office for the rest of the day.
- BE RESPONSIBLE! While in class and in the hallways, the rule is:
“ON SILENT AND OUT OF SIGHT!”



If your cellphone or earbuds are confiscated, you will need to serve an afterschool detention.

HALL PASS (Agenda)

Students asking to leave the classroom for the purpose of washroom use or getting water **must have an agenda**. It acts as your hall pass.

•Leaving the classroom is at your teacher's discretion and should be avoided.

LEAVING SCHOOL PROPERTY DURING LUNCH

- Cycle 1 (grade 7 and 8) students are **NOT PERMITTED** to leave the school property during their lunch break.
- You will have full access to the soccer field and surrounding outdoor space on campus.
- You can eat in the cafeteria, the bistro area, the Mall area, and outside.
- You have full access to the table tennis and Foosball tables.

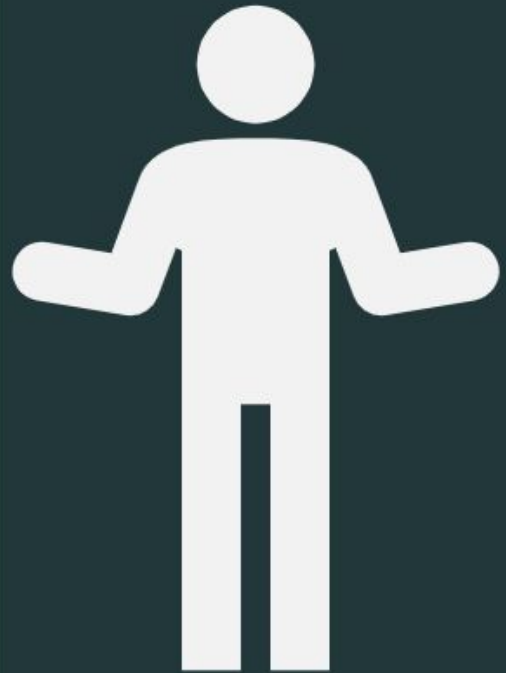
