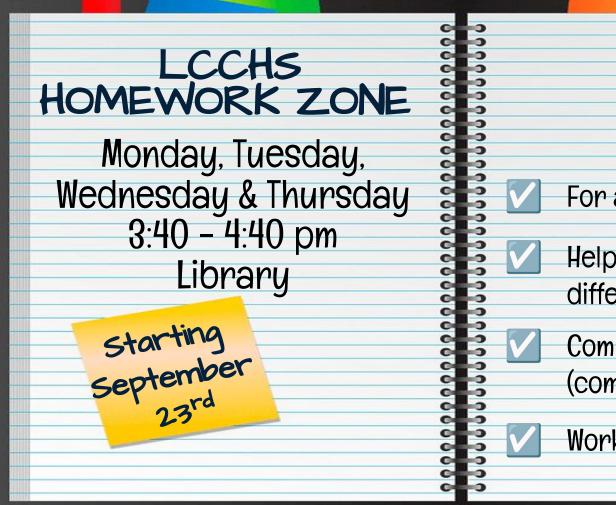
This month we are looking to celebrate the IB learner profile trait of being good <u>"COMMUNICATOR"</u>.
