GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Ministry of Education awards a Secondary School Diploma (SSD) to students who have earned a minimum of 54 credits. At least 20 credits must be from sec. 5.

The following credits are mandatory:

MISSING GRADE 10 CREDITS

What happens if I am missing grade 10 graduation requirements?

Math 4: You have been placed in a grade 10 CST Math class. Grade 11 Math is not required for graduation.

History and/or Science: You have been placed in this grade 10 class this year.

Arts education option: You **MUST** pass your grade 11 arts education option. Once successfully completed, you will receive the grade 10 back-credits for the equivalent class.

IMPORTANT DATES

Oct-Nov 2022: CEGEP Open Houses. See hand-out!

Oct 2022-Feb 2023 Student-for-a-day opportunities to experience what it is like to be a student in a Vocational Education program and/or a CEGEP program!

Mid-January, 2023: CEGEP applications open.

January 31/February 1, 2023: Deadline for out-of-province applications.

February 2023: CEGEP information evenings!

March 1, 2023: Quebec CEGEP application deadline.

March-April, 2023: Vocational Training applications (ongoing).

CEGEP ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

BASIC REQUIREMENT:

- **Secondary School Diploma:** All students need a SSD to apply to CEGEP.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

- **Program Prerequisites:** Programs have specific course requirements. These are called **prerequisites**. Every school has a website with all the info you need!

Examples:

- Health Science: Sec 5 enriched Math (SN), Physics and Chemistry.
- Commerce: Sec. 5 Math (SN)
- Mechanical Engineering Technology: Sec. 4 Math (SN) **or** Sec. 5 Math (CST), and Physics.
- Nursing: Environmental Science & Technology (EST) and Chemistry
- Physiotherapy Technology: Sec. 4 Math (CST), and Physics
- Diagnostic Imaging Technology: Sec. 4 Math (CST) and EST
- **Other program specific requirements** can include:
 - Audition
 - Portfolio
 - Interview
 - Letter of intent
 - Reference letters
 - Drawing test
 - Physical testing, etc.
- Applying to a program for which you will not meet the admission requirements by the end of June will lead to an **automatic refusal**.
- Applying to a program despite meeting the admission requirements by the end of June **does not guarantee admission**. CEGEPs fill their programs with the strongest applicants and must refuse the rest due to a lack of space.
- All programs have a **grade point average requirement** BUT **actual averages** of those who fill the programs tend to be much higher than what is required.
 - **E.g.: Health Science** requires a minimum average of 70% to apply yet the actual minimum average for last year's applicants was 91% at Dawson.
 - **E.g.: Social Science: Law & Society** requires an average of 65% to apply yet the actual minimum average is closer to 80-85%.
- If you meet the **SCIENCE or SOCIAL SCIENCE** program's admission requirements but are **refused due to lack of space, you can start your Science or Social Science DCS through CONTINUING EDUCATION** (a.k.a., evening CEGEP classes).
- If you are refused admission to a daytime CEGEP program other than Science or Social science, you can start your CEGEP studies through Continuing Education's **SPRINGBOARD program (see details under Continuing Education)**.

CEGEP PROGRAMS

3 types of CEGEP programs:

1) Pre-university DCS Programs: 2-year programs based on theory that prepare you for further studies.

Examples of Pre-university CEGEP programs:

- o Pure & Applied Science
- o Health Science
- o Environmental Science
- o Social Science
- o Liberal Arts
- o Arts Literature & Communications (ALC)
- o Communications, Media & Studi Arts
- o Visual Arts
- o Music

2) DOUBLE DCS Programs: 3-year pre-university programs that combine 2 pre-university fields.

Examples for Double DCS programs:

- Science & Social Science
- Science & Music
- Social Science & Music
- Languages & Cultures & Music
- ALC & Music

3) Career / Technology DCS Programs: 3-year programs that are more technical (hands-on) in nature. These programs are designed to give students the knowledge and experience necessary to join the workforce directly upon graduation. **However, many students choose to continue their studies at the university level afterwards, sometimes with advanced standing!**

CORE CURRICULUM CLASSES

All pre-university and career programs include a common general education component:

- ENGLISH
- FRENCH
- HUMANITIES
- PHYSICAL EDUCATION
- COMPLEMENTARY

You must successfully pass all of these to earn your DCS!

CEGEP APPLICATION PROCESS

Application process: Online applications become available in mid-January.

I will be visiting your classes again to explain the process in detail then!

While doing your post-secondary research, keep in mind that **you will be applying to at least 2-3 different CEGEPS and about 4 programs.**

SRAM

You apply to **1 program at 1 SRAM school**:

- **Vanier College**
- **John Abbott College**
- **Champlain College (Lennoxville)**
- **CEGEP Andre Laurendeau (and 25+ other French CEGEPS)**

Although you may only apply to **1 program** through SRAM, there are **3 ROUNDS**.

What are rounds? : You apply to make a **ROUND 1** choice by the March 1st, 2023 deadline. You will receive a notice in late March to early April with a decision. If you are refused in round 1, the notice you receive will include a list of the programs that still have space for a **ROUND 2** choice. The deadline as well as instructions on how to make a new choice will be explained. You do not pay again!

DAWSON COLLEGE / CHAMPLAIN COLLEGE

You make **1 program choice at Dawson College**. If you are refused due to lack of space, you will be told which programs still have space to make a 2nd choice.

You make **1 program choice at Champlain College**. If you are refused due to lack of space, you may be put on a waitlist.

*You can indicate the same first choice program at more than 1 CEGEP but keep in mind that the admission requirements will be roughly the same everywhere so it may be wise to indicate a more accessible program at one of the CEGEPs, i.e., Social Science General Studies..

PRIVATE COLLEGES & SCHOOLS OUTSIDE QC

Marianopolis College (only 2-yr pre-university programs): 1st & 2nd program choice.

Other Private Colleges (e.g., O'Sullivan College & Lasalle College): These have their own admission application systems. See the school websites for details!

Schools outside of Quebec: Deadline tends to be **January 31st** but application deadline dates may vary by school. *Check the school websites!*

CONTINUING EDUCATION (CEGEP evening classes)

Who is Continuing Education for?

Students who wish to upgrade their high school math and/or science for admission into a CEGEP program.

- Math upgrades (Sec 4 & 5): Basic Math (CST) Science Math (SN)
- Sec 4 Science upgrade: ST EST
- Chemistry
- Physics

Students who wish to improve their academic record for daytime admission.

- Students can register for core curriculum classes such as English, French, Humanities, or Complimentary classes. Once completed successfully, students can apply to a daytime program for consideration based on CEGEP class grades and not just high school grades.
- Any CEGEP classes taken through a CEGEP Continuing Education department counts as credits toward your DCS.

Advantages of Cont. Ed.:

- You will have a good sense of what is expected of you in CEGEP, i.e., work ethic, organization skills, time management skills, etc.)
- You will have already completed some of your core curriculum classes once admitted to a daytime program which will lessen your course load ☺
- You can complete your high school advanced math and/or science without any other classes taking up your time.

Deadline to apply: Online applications are in **May-August**. You can therefore decide if this is the path you want only after you hear back from CEGEPS about daytime admission if you prefer day studies.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING (TRADE) REQUIREMENTS

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- Secondary School Diploma (SSD): Access to **ALL** trade programs.
- Grade 10 core classes (English, French, Math): Access to **MOST** programs.
- Grade 9 core classes (English, French, Math): Access to **SOME** programs

SPECIFIC PROGRAMS PREREQUISITES

- **INTERVIEW!** They are looking for mature and motivated candidates!
- Mechanical and/or Mathematical Reasoning Test(s)
