Festival International Nuits d'Afrique





40 Days Of Lent

Lent is a period of 40 days where Jesus fasted and was tempted in the wilderness. Christians are called to prepare for holy week, specifically the crucifixion of Christ and His resurrection three days later on Easter.

This is a season of repentance, prayer, fasting, and almsgiving (giving to the poor).

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday (February 18th), six and a half weeks before Easter. During Lent Christians are called to give up something that they enjoy. (This could be anything from candy to swearing, just as long as it's meaningful.)






Ramadan Kareem
